Eligibility Entry

- 5.1 Eligibility for Freestyle Skiing Ontario events
All competitors must be registered within the **Ontario** Freestyle Division.
- 5.2 General eligibility for all events
All competitors must be a current CFSA member. **Please bring receipt of CFSA registration with you.**
- 5.3 All athletes must be registered to their CFSA divisions. Forms available upon request.
- 5.4 Competitions may require a minimum of 10 competitors in any combination of men/women in order for a given competition to be held
- 5.5 Limited spots available so register ASAP with the competition registrar.
- 5.6 Please register on Karelo or complete and send in the team registration before February 5, 2010.
- 5.7 All competitors must wear HELMETS and their BIBS during all official training and competitions. A deposit of \$20.00 per bib will be charged upon registration. At the end of the season competitors are allowed to keep their bibs.
- 5.8 **LIABILITY**
All athletes, officials and other members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, sponsors and Alpine Ski Club shall not be held responsible for any risks, dangers and hazards as well as the possibility of personal injuries, death, damages to property or loss caused by or occurring during the event, to athletes, officials and other related parties in connection with the organization or staging of the event.
- 5.9 **MEDICAL INSURANCE**
Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance; The Organizing Committee, sponsors and Alpine Ski Club decline any responsibilities for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims.
- 5.10 **EVENT MEETING**
The event meeting time will be announced at registration. Competition format and age groups will be announced at the event meeting.

Lift tickets will be available each morning at registration at a cost of \$30.
