GENERAL INFORMATION:

The F.I.S. freestyle General Rules and Regulations and policies in Canadian Series procedures shall govern competition guidelines.

The competitions are composed of the following:

- **Single Mogul Competition:** Best of two runs for both men and women.

The results will be eligible for the Southern Ontario RPA ranking system.

Eligibility Entry

- 5.1 Eligibility for Southern Ontario Freestyle events
All competitors must be on a team registered within the **Ontario** Freestyle Division.
- 5.2 General eligibility for all events
All competitors must be a current CFSA member and represented by a registered CFSA coach.
***Note: CFSA membership forms are available at the competition.**
Bring your membership card to registration with you.
- 5.3 All teams must be registered to their CFSA divisions. Forms available upon request.
- 5.4 Competitions require a minimum of 10 competitors in any combination of men/women in order for a given competition to be held
- 5.5 Limited spots available so register your athletes ASAP with the competition registrar.
- 5.6 Please register the team on Karelo or complete and send in the team registration A.S.A.P. before February 14th to the registrar by e-mail cara@ontariofreestyle.com
- 5.7 All competitors must wear HELMETS and their BIBS during all official training and competitions. A deposit of \$20.00 per bib will be charged upon registration.
- 5.8 **LIABILITY**
All athletes, officials and other members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, sponsors and Beaver Valley Ski Club shall not be held responsible for any risks, dangers and hazards as well as the possibility of personal injuries, death, damages to property or loss caused by or occurring during the event, to athletes, officials and other related parties in connection with the organization or staging of the event.



- 5.9 **MEDICAL INSURANCE**
Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance; The Organizing Committee, sponsors and Beaver Valley Ski Club decline any responsibilities for accidents, damaged equipment and second and third party claims.
- 5.10 **TEAM LEADERS' MEETINGS**
Team Leaders' meeting will be held Friday after training and Saturday after medal presentations in a designated meeting room in the Main Lodge.
- 5.11 **LIFT TICKETS**
Lift tickets will be available each morning at registration.
The cost is **\$30.00/athlete/day for training- coaches are free**
Lift tickets for competition days are free of charge to registered athletes and coaches
- 5.12 **ACCOMMODATIONS**
There are no official accommodations for this event

Age Categories

Single Moguls

Mogul age categories shall be held in the standard M1 through M6 and F1 through F6. If, at the close of Final Registration for an event, there are fewer than five athletes registered in a given age category, the age categories in that event shall, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be merged into the higher category.

Dual Moguls

Age categories will be combined to create two groups of M1-M3 and M4-M6 for men and women. If, at the close of Final Registration for an event, there are fewer than five athletes registered in a given age category, the age categories in that event shall, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be merged into the higher category.
