2. The Competition will be held under F.I.S. Rules and Regulations for Freestyle Skiing and CFSA Specific Regulations and Procedures for the Canadian Junior Championships.
3. It is the responsibility of each province to ensure that every athlete holds a valid Canadian Competitor or FIS card license.
4. The Competition is comprised of three (3) events.
5. The Competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Event Schedule.

(The organizing committee reserves the right to change the Event Schedule).

Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance and a valid CFSA Membership. The Organizing Committee, Ski Wentworth and the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged equipment and/or second or third party claims during the staging of the event.

REGISTRATION

Entries – Please pre-register as a provincial team. Team Captains or Coaches must provide the completed registration form as attached no later than January 29, 2010. Entries will be accepted from all eligible competitors according to the quotas established by CFSA. Participating provinces will be responsible for payment of entry fees on the basis of the number of athletes submitted on their list. Completed forms are to be sent by email or fax to:

Entry Fees – The base entry fee shall be \$75 for each competitor. There shall be an additional fee for each athlete of \$25 per event entered. (Athletes compete in one event \$100, two events \$125, three events \$150).

Please note: If an event is cancelled, each athlete that is registered for that event will be refunded \$20.00. The maximum refund that will be paid to any one athlete (if more than one event is cancelled) is \$40.00.

Tickets – Lift tickets shall be \$75.00 for the entire 5 day event (training and competition days). Three complimentary coach lift tickets will be provided per province for the event. Parents and friends can buy tickets at the “regular” price (\$40.00 per day).

Payment is to be received no later than February 5, 2010 and to be based upon the attached payment schedule. Payment to include entry fees, lift ticket costs, and banquet costs for all athletes as per previous registration.

Bibs – A bib deposit of \$30 per athlete is required. Bibs must be worn on all sites during official training and for all events. A bib deposit must be made with one cheque per province, made out to Freestyle Ski Nova Scotia and to be delivered to the Competitions Office prior to picking up the bibs. The cheque will only be cashed if all the bibs are not returned at the end of the event. The provinces will be charged \$30 for each bib missing and the remainder will be refunded no later than two weeks after the event.

Bios – each athlete must complete a Biography. Coaches or Team Captains are to provide the Bios for the team, to the organizing committee upon team registration in Wentworth.

Registration – Each province is to designate one person (coach, team captain) to pick up bibs, lift tickets and banquet tickets from the Competition Office for each province. Bibs will not be handed out to individual athletes.

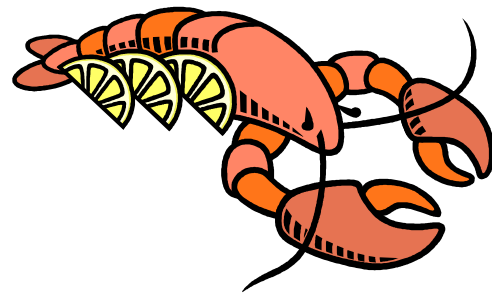
